Materials we will provide:

Brayers

Water containers

Printmaking inks - relief or intaglio

Latex gloves

Materials you will need to bring:

Brayer if you have one

Drawing materials & *drawing paper

Your own inks if you wish

Wax paper or blotter paper to transport your prints home

Found materials such as leaves, stems, flowers, moss, feathers, grasses, seeds. These should be thin and lie flat for best results.

*Paper (tracing paper, Mulberry paper, strong tissue paper, printmaking paper, other) for shade: 16" by 10". You could make several shades. Bring your choice of what you want to work with.
